Fires Reported in FireRMS

October 12, 2018, 8:58 PM- East Lansing Fire dispatched as Mutual Aid to Meridian Township at 4965 Campus Hill in Meridian Township at 2109 hours. Truck, Medic, and Battalion 11 were assigned to the call and responded with seven personnel. En route Command reported that it was a small fire confined to the stove. Meridian Command cancelled all East Lansing Fire units.

October 13, 2018, 12:06 AM- T-12 was dispatched to a possible structure fire. T-12 at medium sized 3 story apartment building with nothing showing. T-12 est. Command and advised all incoming units to Level #1 stage. T-12 crew investigated to find that apartment #1 was cooking and burned food on the stove. No damage to structure or surrounding kitchen area with a light haze throughout the unit and hallways. The apartment was being ventilated with fan by occupants upon our arrival. T-12 notified B-11 of situation and cleared all units. T-12 ventilated the apartment building and then cleared the scene.

October 13, 2018, 7:35 PM- Dispatched to 100 block of Oakhill for couch fire. Enroute emergent from Station 1 with 3 aboard Truck 11. Arrived on scene, remnants of couch fire burning in alleyway. Put out fire with shovel and bucket of water. Moved the couch carcass near the dumpster. Truck 11 clear.

October 13, 2019, 7:48 PM- Called for couch fire in the street. Arrival and have many pieces of furniture piled and burning in the middle of the street. Pulled the trash line and put it out. City trucks came and we loaded the items into the trucks and open the street up. T 12 cleared.
