**Fires Reported in FireRMS**

**December 2 2018, 5:19 am-** Dispatched for reported structure fire in Meridian TWP. Canceled in route. MTFD found burned up motor in furnace room. T-11 cleared and returned to station.

**November 4, 2018, 3:57 pm-** T11 on the road and in the North end, dispatched to a lawn mower on fire at a School. Dispatch stated the lawn mower was outside an out building and the building was next to the football field. Arrived to loading dock area of the school, on the North end, and were initially unable to locate the fire. ELPD drove East across the field to and found the fire. This is a maintenance storage building on the East side of the school property. We moved T11 to baseball parking lot and staged. Took tools and portable extinguisher about 150 yards back to 1635 building.

Found a push mower, on the North side of the building, smoldering. ELPD stated they used a dry chemical extinguisher to put out a little bit of flame. No extension on the outside of the building. We used a water can to soak the area and the mower. ELPS staff on scene and gave us access to the building. No extension into the building.

Informed by ELPS that the mower was not theirs and must have been brought to this location by unknown person. They also stated about 3 weeks ago, there was another push mower fire on the other side of the same out building. Again, the mower did not belong to ELPS. They did not call ELFD for this fire because it had burnt itself out before being found. They showed us the burned grass on the South side of the building.

**Training Reported in FireRMS**

**November 29, 2018, 2 Hours- SCBA Training** - Captains established an obstacle course at station #1. FF's were to don their SCBA's and complete the course, noting air consumption and familiarity with firefighting practices.
