The Parks and Recreation Advisory Commission of the City of East Lansing, Ingham County, Michigan ("City") will hold its regularly scheduled meeting on Wednesday, October 21, 2020 at 7:00 pm. However, this meeting will only be held electronically pursuant to the Open Meetings Act, Act 267 of 1976, and the capacity restrictions and social distancing requirements set forth in the MDHHS Director's Emergency Orders. 1. **Reason for Electronic Meeting**. The City is holding this meeting by electronic means only due to the restrictions imposed by the MDHHS Director's Emergency Orders. If the Orders are revised and if an in-person meeting is to be held instead of an electronic meeting, the meeting may be rescheduled to a different date and time. Notice of any such change will be posted at the City Hall and on the City's website.

2. **Procedures**. The public may view the meeting on the City's public meeting portal and may provide public comment via telephone.
