



**RESOLUTION NO. 2022-16**

**RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT ADVISORY COMMITTEE**

At a meeting of the City Council of the City of East Lansing, Ingham County, Michigan, held on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2022, at 7:00 p.m.

**PRESENT:** Mayor Bacon, Mayor Pro Tem Gregg, Councilmember Babcock, Councilmember Brookover, and Councilmember Watson

**ABSENT:** None

The following preamble and resolution was offered by Councilmember Brookover and seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Gregg.

WHEREAS the City of East Lansing is considered an Entitlement Community from the Federal Department of Housing and Urban Development; and therefore, the recipient of federal Community Development Block Grant funds; and

WHEREAS, the City of East Lansing, through its Citizen Participation Plan, encourages public participation in decisions made regarding the use of CDBG funds; and

WHEREAS the City of East Lansing desires to expand the Community Development Block Grant program's public participation process to include more community stakeholders and feedback for Council to consider as part of its annual budget process; and

WHEREAS, the City of East Lansing has many citizen commissions with talent and expertise that will be useful to the CDBG program; and

WHEREAS, East Lansing City Council approved Policy Resolution 2021-17 on October 5, 2021. This resolution established the Community Development Advisory Committee with the following membership: one (1) non-voting City Council liaison, the chair or the chair's designee and an additional representative from the Human Rights Commission, and the chair or the chair's designee from the following commissions: Housing Commission, Parks and Recreation Advisory Commission, Seniors Commission, Transportation Commission, and the University Student Commission; and

WHEREAS, as of September 20, 2022, East Lansing City Council would like to make modifications to the CD Advisory Committee membership established by Policy Resolution 2021-17; and

WHEREAS, this resolution, Policy Resolution 2022-16, supplants Policy Resolution 2021-17; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Community Development Advisory Committee is hereby established and shall consist of one (1) non-voting City Council liaison, the chair or the chair's designee and an additional representative from the Human Rights Commission, and the chair or the chair's designee from the following commissions: Commission on the Environment, Housing Commission, Parks and Recreation Advisory Commission, Planning Commission, Seniors Commission, Transportation Commission, and the University Student Commission; and


