

NOTICE OF PROJECT PLANNING PUBLIC MEETING

The City of East Lansing will hold a public meeting on proposed water meter and reading system replacements, water main improvements, new elevated water storage tank, and lead service line replacement projects for the purpose of receiving comments from interested persons. The meeting will be held at **5 p.m. on April 20, 2023** at the following location:

East Lansing Department of Public Works

1800 E. State Road, East Lansing, MI 48823

The purpose of the proposed projects is to improve drinking water quality and reliability. The projects will address this by expanding system storage, minimizing water loss by replacing equipment past its expected useful life, increasing water main size where necessary to meet demand, and replacing lead pipes.

Project construction will occur from approximately 2024 to 2028 and will involve city-wide water meter replacements, water main improvements in the Red Cedar, East Glencairn, and Lantern Hill neighborhoods, construction of a new elevated water storage tank in the Red Cedar neighborhood area (northeast of US-127 and Trowbridge Road), and lead service line replacements located at various areas of the City.

Impacts of the proposed projects will include temporary traffic disruptions and noise from construction activities during daylight, weekday hours.

The approximate cost of each project is shown below.

Project	Project Cost
Project 1: AMI Water Meter Replacement	\$7,446,000
Project 2: Red Cedar Water Main	\$7,723,000
Project 3: 500,000 Gallon Elevated Tank	\$7,168,000
Project 4: East Glencairn Water Main	\$11,682,000
Project 5: Lantern Hill Water Main	\$4,741,000
Project 6: Lead Service Line Replacement	\$5,000,000

The estimated cost to users if all of the projects are constructed based on these approximate costs will be approximately \$16.50 per user per quarter.
