

# ELECTRIC SCOOTERS

## Driving

- Scooters can be operated in **bike lanes** and on **sidewalks** in East Lansing. The speed limit on sidewalks is 10 mph.
- No more than one person can ride a scooter at a time.
- Do not operate scooters while intoxicated.
- **Be respectful of pedestrians**, slow down and use audible signals when passing.
- **Wear a helmet.**
- Follow all traffic laws, including street signs and stop signs.
- **Use caution at crosswalks.**

## Parking

Park scooters **upright** with at least **five feet of unobstructed sidewalk** for pedestrians. If parking a scooter on a street, be sure that vehicle and bike lanes are unobstructed.

When parking a scooter, be sure not to interfere with the following:

- sidewalks
- crosswalks
- sidewalk ramps
- bus stops
- shelters
- waiting areas
- loading zones
- disability parking
- fire hydrants
- benches
- parking meters
- pay stations
- commercial window displays
- access to buildings
- bicycle racks
- streets
- driveways/alleys
- vehicular parking spaces
